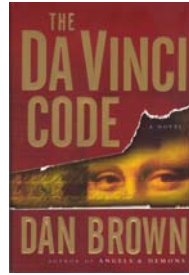


DA VINCI CODE

Blockbuster Movie, Bestselling Book & International Phenomenon



The Book:

The Da Vinci Code, a New York Times #1 bestseller and one of the best-selling novels of all time, was written by Dan Brown. Brown is the author of numerous bestselling novels - in early 2004, all four of Dan Brown's novels held spots on the New York Times bestseller list during the same week. He was recently named one of the World's 100 Most Influential People by TIME Magazine.

The Movie:

Slated for release May 19, 2006, the Sony Pictures production Da Vinci Code stars Tom Hanks, Audrey Tatou, Ian McKellen, Alfred Molina and Jurgen Prochnow. Oscar-award winner Ron Howard is the director. Produced by Brian Grazer, and John Calley. It is rated PG-13.

The Plot:

The murder of a curator at the Louvre reveals a sinister plot – a plot to uncover a stunning secret that has been protected since the early days of Christ. Robert Langdon, a famed symbologist, and the victim's granddaughter, are the only people with a chance to solve the mystery of the clues the curator left behind. Facing danger and intrigue, the two become both suspects and detectives. In their search, they will learn not only the identity of the murderer, but the stunning secret of the ages he was charged to protect?

Film Location: Chateau Villette, Paris, France

Chateau Villette is featured as the residence of central character Sir Leigh Teabing, a British royal historian who revealed the secret of the Da Vinci Code.
